

Inland Empire Swimming Athlete Support (Senior Travel)

1. Swimmer Support will be determined annually by the IE Senior Chairman and IES Coaches and approved by the HOD. The budget amount will be determined each year. This total amount shall be disbursed to each IE team by the following point system given to the following agreed upon USA Swimming meets:

USA Swimming Short Course Nationals (Atlanta) 4pts.

USA Swimming Junior National Championships (Austin) 4pts.

USA Swimming World Championship Trials Indianapolis (4pts)

USA Swimming Grand Prix Series Meet (1pt)

(Note: Will only receive reimbursement for (1) Grand Prix Series meet)

USA Swimming Long Course US Open 2009(Federal Way) 3 pts.

USA Swimming Long Course Junior Nationals 2009 (Fed. Way) 2pts.

Each team will receive points for only one participating coach, and each participating swimmer attending each of the above approved meets.

Each IES coach will submit a request form to the IES Senior Chair by August 15th. The IES Senior Chair will make every effort to make sure all teams eligible to receive funds turn in their request form by the deadline. The IES Senior Chair will provide Travel fund Team disbursement amounts to the IES Treasurer. Disbursement payments are to be paid to teams by August 30th.

2. Swimmer Eligibility:

Swimmers must have competed and represented an IES swim club during the previous 12 continuous months. Each swimmer must have competed in two short course and one long course Inland Empire swim meets during the year.

3. Returning Alumni: Prior to competing at the collegiate level, swimmers must have competed, during their last year of high school, representing an IES team. If they wish to apply for travel funds during their collegiate career, they must compete for an IES team during the non collegiate season.

4. Relay only swimmers: $\frac{1}{2}$ point value of individual qualifier/participants.

5. Available funding: Funds will be determined annually in the IES budgeting process.
